- The Tests and Patterns Are Available on The **WDAA** Website. **NAHA** will be using the Tests from **WDAA**, but it is **not a sanctioned show**. Can ride one or 2 handed in approved bit.

- All exhibitors must be appropriately attired for their chosen classes when entering the show ring. Western classes must be in Western tack.
- Helmets are recommended while mounted, and part of the attire when showing in English tack.
- The Judge or Show Committee may cancel or combine any class with less than 6 entries.
- Any horse not under control may be excused from the show grounds by the Judge or Show Committee.
- Horse abuse will not be tolerated, and you will be excused from the show grounds.
- All dogs must be on a leash and the leash in hand.
- NO bicycles, motorcycles or alcohol are permitted on the show grounds.
- All complaints must be made through the Show Secretary.
- No refunds without a Vet certificate or the class is cancelled.
