- THE SHOW COMMITTEE OR JUDGE MAY CANCEL OR COMBINE ANY CLASS WITH LESS THAN 6 ENTRIES.
- ANY HORSE NOT UNDER CONTROL MAY BE EXCUSED FROM THE SHOW GROUNDS BY THE JUDGE OR SHOW COMMITTEE.
- HORSE ABUSE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED, AND YOU WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AND THE LEASH IN HAND.
- NO BICYCLES, MOTORCYCLES OR ALCOHOL ARE PERMITTED.
- ALL COMPLAINTS MUST BE MADE THROUGH THE SHOW SECRETARY.
- NO REFUNDS WITHOUT A VET EXCUSE OR A CLASS IS CANCELLED.
